

biennial completes life cycle in 2 years, usually flowering in 2nd year

bract leaf or scale below calvx; parts of cone

calyx collection of individual or, usually, joined sepals cosmopolitan belonging to many or all parts of the world Iflts leaflets - leaf-like parts of compound leaf shaped like a lance head; long, tapering to end lanceolate palmate having lobes or leaflets like spread fingers

with series of leaflets on each side of a central stalk pinnate

protects bud before flower opens, forms leaf-like ring at base of flower, usually green sepals

tnh temperate northern hemisphere trefoil leaf with three leaflets or lobes

flower cluster with stalks joined in centre to form flat or curved surface; umbrella-like umbel

whorl ring of leaves around stem
